They are charged with the responsibility of making sure communication between all parties is constant and clear, and with making sure our safety is our first priority, plus confirming timelines, status of permitting, and that construction is going as planned. Please see their first report below.

Court Construction Update

Our newly formed Construction Task Force has met several times to review what we know, what we need to know, and to develop a plan.

The first issue we noticed was the dimensions of Courts 3 & 4 on the site plan that the professional engineering company, DMK Associates, submitted to the SouthWest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD) on Dec 27, 2021 did not include sufficient out of bounds space. That prompted the Task Force to immediately meet with Mitch Krach, ML General Manager, and to also contact the Engineer, John Pari of DMK Associates.

After several meetings and phone calls which included discussions about our Task Force members' other recommendations such as placement of gates, insisting the fencing between Courts 3 & 4 be increased from 3 feet to 8 feet, and increasing the seating area with retractable sunshade, we are happy to report with confidence that we are making

positive progress.

The engineer has provided SWFWMD with all outstanding items they have requested and based on our most recent communication we believe the permit from SWFWMD should be approved within the next few weeks. Contracts are already awarded for the construction of the new courts which will be 31 x 64 each to meet pickleball standard court sizes. We are also working on the feasibility of bleachers between courts 2 & 3.

We have been told the Charlotte County Building Dept has preliminarily approved building permits which should put construction on a fast track.

However, before the actual construction of the courts takes place, the following has to happen:

- 1. the Rampart Center building has to be moved
- 2. the whole area has to be graded
- 3. trees removed
- 4. berm will be moved further towards the golf course
- 5. utility lines installed

After the court surfaces have been graded and poured, it will take a minimum of 45 days for the court surface to cure. Then of course they are painted, then nets and fencing installed.

We will continue to keep you advised of any new developments and timelines. Thank you for your understanding and patience.
